

On June 04, 2010 the Taxonomy Recognition Task Force (TRTF) of XBRL International granted "Acknowledged" status to the Japan EDINET 2010 Taxonomy. This is a large taxonomy, consisting of many components - accordingly this page of description is provided to assist in understanding what has been acknowledged.
