XBRL Showcase incorporates demonstrations, proofs of concept and implementations to serve as one-stop shop for XBRL implementers

XBRL International announced today the launch of the XBRL Showcase, a web-based repository of XBRL project information available to the public through the XBRL website. The Showcase is a one-stop shop for comprehensive XBRL implementation information and will provide visitors specific project details as reported directly from the project managers who are implementing XBRL. This allows interested parties the ability to research XBRL with information from real life use cases. It will include the following key components:

- **XBRL In Action** - A collection of XBRL implementations, pilots, and proofs of concept.
- **The XBRL Resource Centre** – An information centre open to anyone desiring to submit works of reference, including case studies, white papers, and presentations.
- **The XBRL Directory** – A guide to XBRL products and services

XBRL International intends to further develop the Showcase by continuing to capture and report project information as the standard evolves.
